
Tuition & Classroom Policies

- Tuition paid is Non-Refundable and cannot be applied to any other session unless prior permission is received from Musik'n'Motion.
- There are no refunds for missed classes, however make-up classes may be prearranged with the office subject to space and availability.
- There will be no Make-Up classes in the case of Typhoons or other "Acts of nature" (including government requested closures). For your child's class status under these circumstances, please call the office on 2559 9556 for recorded updates.
- Only the child REGISTERED may attend classes and each child must be accompanied by ONE adult; either a parent, caregiver or domestic helper, as required by government regulations and business insurance policies. Any visiting siblings or friends must be pre-arranged with the office prior to the commencement of class. If permission is granted, a visiting child must be accompanied by an additional adult to sit on the side with them, or entry into the music room is not permitted.
- We do not want to take anything away from the children and ask that you please do not bring toys, food, or drink into the music room. For hygiene purposes, these are not permitted.
- Please, absolutely no ringing cell phones. We also ask that adults refrain from conversation during the music lesson. Talking during music listening and singing takes away from the music experience and the lesson. Please be considerate to others and refrain from conversation. While we encourage new friendships, there will be time before and after classes to chat. Thank you.
- Please be patient with your child and allow them to watch until they are comfortable enough to join in. Observing the class is just as important as participating, as they are absorbing what is going on around them.
- This is a nurturing environment that teaches music and musical concepts in a way that children learn - not adults. Please remember not to compare. This is your time with your child.

- This class is not about entertainment, rather it is a unique educational experience! The teacher acts as the facilitator teaching you ideas you can use with your child at home to help you bond with your child through a deeply educational music program. This is your special time with your child and we ask that you please participate fully in all activities so that your child may get the most out of music class. The results in musical development over time are very rewarding!
- Using your Family Materials will often make your little one more eager to join in these familiar activities in class. Please use your CD to sing along in the car or at home. The key to success is REPETITION!!! Children love what they know! Repetition will increase their enjoyment and participation as well as their language development, timing and singing skills.
- **Please do your best to arrive on time for class.** Classes run at 15 minute intervals and we ask that parents understand these constraints. Consistent attendance in class and on time arrival will help ensure your child's confidence, participation and musical growth. It also minimises class disruption.
- Above all, please remember that **your participation in class is essential,** especially for your youngster. The parent's participation demonstrates that this is a worthwhile activity; it enhances the validity of participation during music activities.
- Our instruments are made from 100% natural wood so they are safe if your child puts them in their mouths. They are completely non-toxic. We also clean our instruments with hospital grade Chlorhexidine Gluconate (Hibitane) after every class! This kills all germs and is completely non-toxic and safe for your child.
- If your child is sick please refrain from attending class. You may request for a make up class (except during the Summer Camp classes).
- Musical Achievement Certificates will be handed out at the end of a full term (except during the Summer Camp classes). To qualify for a certificate, your child must have registered at the commencement of term only, and have attended 75% of the terms classes.

PLEASE REMEMBER...

... that all children learn at different rates and in different ways. Some children will be quiet in class, others will be active. Some children will do everything perfectly at home, but not in class. As a parent, you know that every child is unique, so please leave your comparisons at the door and let the music work its magic!
